



Code of Conduct for Young People Online

This Code of Conduct for Young People Online is written to keep you and your Holy Redeemer leaders safe. Please read it carefully and abide by it at all times in future Youth Group Zoom meetings. To be involved in one of our Zoom meetings you must be at Secondary School (i.e. turning 12 in this academic year).

DO:

- Ask your parent/guardian for permission to be involved in a Zoom meeting online.
- Access the meeting using your parent/guardian's Zoom account (to sign up for a Zoom account you have to be over 16).
- Make sure your parent/guardian knows exactly what you're doing.
- Follow the instructions on the email invitation in order to join the meeting safely.
- Only attempt to enter the Zoom meeting at the specified time.
- Make sure you are appropriately dressed - as you would be to come to the Parish Hall.
- Use a computer, tablet, mobile or device in a public place (i.e. not in your bedroom).
- Ensure that your activity online is visible to others at home.
- Sign in using your full name (first name and surname).
- Behave as you would at a face-to-face Holy Redeemer Youth Group meeting.
- Have fun!

DO NOT:

- Attempt to share your screen in Zoom.
- Use the whiteboard facility unless asked to by your Youth Group leader.
- Attempt to initiate a Zoom call with your Youth Group leaders.
